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Treatment duration 10-15 minutes (or as directed by clinician)- The Lidcombe Program Manual states that the home treatment conversation should last between 10-15 minutes. In clinical practice, a clinician may recommend a different length of time based on parent/child factors.

The Lidcombe Program Treatment Guide states that percent syllables stuttered is no longer essential. What measures are used now to determine whether a child is ready for Stage 2. A behavioural treatment The Lidcombe Program is a behavioural treatment, which targets children's stuttered speech. During the Lidcombe Program treatment children are not instructed to change their customary speech pattern in any way. Parents do not alter their customary speech and language habits in any way, nor do they change the

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The Lidcombe Program treatment goal during Stage 1 is for the child to speak with no stuttering or almost no stuttering, and the goal of Stage 2 is for no stuttering or almost no stuttering to be sustained for a long time. The design was a parallel, open plan, noninferiority randomized controlled trial of the standard Lidcombe Program treatment and the experimental webcam Lidcombe Program treatment. Participants were 49 children aged 3 years 0 months to 5 years 11 months at the start of treatment. Primary outcomes were the percentage of syllables stuttered at 9 months postrandomization and the number of consultations to complete Stage 1 of the Lidcombe Program.
