If you are using a completely manual lens, or a legacy lens, everything except the shutter speed will now be manipulated using the lens. The aperture will be controlled using the aperture selector ring, and so too will be the focusing.

First, use settings tab 3 to enable "Release W/O Lens". Without this it won't work: Then tab 2, set "Peaking Level" to Mid or High (whichever works for you. Set "Peaking Color" to your liking (yellow is my favorite): Last (but not least), you can ...

You should be able to mount the lens and 'use' it in Manual mode only, but you'll have no metering of any kind, so you'd be using old-school metering with a light meter or Sunny 16 rule or something.
